## The Red Cross in Marshall County

### *Disaster Relief and Community Disaster Education*

When a disaster threatens or strikes, the Red Cross is there. Over the past two years we responded to 24 structure fires, affecting 73 people. We helped 26 affected families with emergency food, shelter and supplies as a result of residential fires. Additionally, we provided canteen services to first responders on 171 woodland fire incidents.

Because being prepared can make your family and community safer and sometimes minimize injury and destruction, we made presentations to 355 attendees of disaster education classes in the community.

### *Health and Safety Services*

From first aid, CPR and AED training to swimming and life guarding, American Red Cross programs help people lead safer and healthier lives. Over the past two years, 218 individuals learned various lifesaving skills through classes offered by the chapter.

### *Armed Forces Emergency Services*

The American Red Cross provides communication between those in the Armed Forces and their families. We have a worldwide network that reaches service members wherever they are to communicate a birth, death or illness. This year we provided 18 emergency connections.

### *Community and Volunteer Services*

We depend on volunteers of all ages and backgrounds to carry on our work. Volunteers constitute 97 percent of our total workforce, serving as members of the board, instructors teaching lifesaving skills, disaster action team members, office administrators, event organizers and more.

This year, dozens of volunteers made the work of the chapter possible, contributing countless hours. Their efforts truly make this chapter effective.

### *Our Dependence on Voluntary Contributions*

All Red Cross disaster services are provided free to our clients. We are completely dependent upon our donors for their voluntary contributions to assist those in need. Our donors' assistance is crucial to our chapter, and sincerely appreciated.
